




#### WIKI MAP





## PRIORITIZATION RESULTS




#### **HIGH SCORERS:**



- Maintains MUTCD Standard colors.



- Modified (D11-1) bike guide signs include sunburst bike logo based on South Santa Barbara County bike wayfinding sign
- Decision signs (with arrows) separate plaques from confirmation sign (with milage).
- 3 color logo (3A), or MUTCD Standard Colors (3B).
