ITEM 1 CALL TO ORDER

Chair Ilasin called the meeting to order at 1:30 p.m.

ITEM 2 INTRODUCTIONS & ANNOUNCEMENTS

Aaron Bonfilio, VCTC, announced that the Collective Bargaining Agreement has been ratified for MV Transportation.

ITEM 3 PUBLIC COMMENT

ITEM 4 AGENDA ADJUSTMENTS

ITEM 5 APPROVAL OF MEETING MINUTES

ACTION

Fleisch moved, seconded by Bonfilio, and passed 2/0 that the Committee approve the February 13, 2017 meeting minutes. Rowlands abstained.

ITEM 6 VALLEY EXPRESS SERVICE ANALYSIS AND DRAFT BUDGET OPTIONS

Mr. Bonfilio requested that the Committee provide direction regarding the Fiscal Year 2017-18 level of service and draft budget. He proposed three options: A) minimal change to Fixed Route with Dial-A-Ride expansion, B) Fixed Route reduction with Dial-A-Ride expansion, and C) equitable split of Option B.

Mr. Bonfilio described Option A as having minor route updates to the fixed route service with implementation of general public Dial-A-Ride with no policy restriction on use (elimination of "restricted" general rider areas and continuation of paratransit services. Option B includes a reduction of fixed route service on weekdays during off-peak hours, and elimination of fixed route

in Santa Paula and in Fillmore on the weekends and implementation of general public dial-a-ride with no policy restrictions on use (elimination of "restricted" general rider areas and continuation of paratransit service. Option C is an equitable split of Option B with a return to the even 1/3 financial split between member agencies as previously done at service implementation.

Discussion

The Committee discussed 1) increasing fares, 2) eliminating service during off-peak hours, 3) support of Option B, 4) stabilizing the service, 5) appropriately compensating VCTC for administering the service, and 6) increasing general Dial-A-Ride service.

ACTION

Fleisch moved, seconded by Rowlands, that the Committee recommend that staff and Committee members determine the targeted cuts using the level of service found in Option B, use the cost-share formula found in Option B, and review and revisit the fare structure and pricing. The motion passed unanimously.

ITEM 7 DETERMINE THE NEXT MEETING DATE AND LOCATION

The next regularly scheduled meeting of the Heritage Valley Technical Advisory Committee is scheduled for May 18th at 3:00 p.m. in the City of Santa Paula Council Chambers and June 27th at 1:30 p.m. in the City of Fillmore Council Chambers.

RECOMMENDATION

• Approval of the draft Dial-a-ride Reservation Policies and Procedures

• Approval of the draft Fixed Route schedules

Recommendation of draft August 2017 Fare Increases for the PAC's Consideration

BACKGROUND:

At the last Heritage Valley Technical Advisory Committee (TAC), held on April 17, 2017, the Committee adopted recommendations for the Heritage Valley Policy Advisory Committee (PAC) to consider; which included, changes to the service levels, Dial-a-ride Policies, and the Fiscal Year 2017/2018 budget. The HVPAC subsequently met and approved for implementation Dial-a-ride policy changes, a shift in contract service hours from Fixed Route to Dial-a-ride, and the Fiscal Year 2017/2018 budget.

SERVICE CHANGE

The approved operational service changes were:

- Expansion of the "General Public Dial-a-ride" (GPDAR) service area, (see attached "before and after" map in Attachment A)
- Reduction of the Fixed Route mode at certain times based on utilization

The first of these changes are set for August 16 and then August 17, 2017, in Santa Paula and Fillmore, respectively¹. These dates coincide with the start of the 2017-2018 school years for each city. As part of the normal service/schedule change process staff has begun working on the timetables in consultation with the operator as well as initiated development of the standard collateral materials (service change promotional items, route brochures, etc.). The draft timetables are attached for review in Attachment A. Additionally, updated GPDAR policies and procedures for reservations are included in this attachment.

FARE INCREASE

¹ Service changes along the Piru Fixed Route will coincide with the Fillmore Fixed Route change.

In addition to changes related to service, both the TAC and PAC reiterated the existing desire to evaluate and then proceed with fare price adjustments.

Each year since its inception, the Valley Express bus service has not attained the required 10% farebox recovery and experienced a fare shortfall. This coming fiscal year, based on the operational budget and existing fare pricing, the anticipated shortfall for Fiscal Year 2017-2018 is approximately \$64,000. That is, farebox recovery equal to 10% of the operating budget is equal to \$183,910, and, the current trend in farebox recovery—based on amended service levels—is projected to be approximately 6.5% or \$119,750 by year-end. While this shortfall may decrease somewhat with a shift in rider utilization from the Fixed Route mode to Dial-a-ride mode, to mitigate the likely shortfall and as previously requested, changes to the fare structure are presented for the TAC's consideration and further recommendation to the PAC.

At the June 5, 2017 HVTAC meeting staff will present multiple fare price increase scenarios for the TAC's consideration. These scenarios (Attachment B) were developed based on the primary goal of attaining the 10% TDA-required farebox recovery ratio. Analysis comparing the projected benefits/risks of each is in progress. The scenarios are: 1) a proposal by the Chair / City of Santa Paula; 2) "Phase two" of TAC/PAC approved fare changes; and 3) changes developed by staff. These scenarios are reflected in Attachment B.

DIAL-A-RIDE: Reservations and Scheduling Policies

New; Deleted = effective August 2017 schedule change

Reservations

ADA Certified Passengers

Reservations can be made up to seven days in advance and in no case less than twenty-four (24) hours in advance for a guaranteed reservation. Space permitting, same day reservations may be accepted (excluding trips to Ventura via transfer to Gold Coast Access at Wells Road). There is no guarantee of trip availability for same day reservations. Reservations can be made seven days a week, Sunday through Saturday. ADA Paratransit Reservations made in advance are given priority before General Public Reservations made on sameday.

General Public Passengers

Service is available on an on-demand "first come, first served" basis. Trip requests will only be honored if the trip begins and/or ends more than one quarter (1/4) mile away from any Valley Express bus stop. Trips that begin and end within this distance are not eligible for reservation. Trip requests should be called in at least two hours before requested pickup time, as space is limited. Day-before advance reservations are allowed only if the requested pickup occurs during the first two and half hours of service (6:00-8:30 AM weekdays, or 8-10:30 AM weekends). In addition to reserved trips, General Public Dialaride Vehicles will meet with the Highway 126 buses in each City for flag pickups. Passengers are encouraged to call ahead their reservations to guarantee a seat.

Subscription Reservations

ADA Certified Passengers:

ADA Certified passengers may request standing order "subscription" for trips that repeat at the same time, on the same day(s); such as for travel to school or work. Subscriptions may be for one day, (e.g. occur every Tuesday at 1:30 PM); or for multiple days, (e.g. every Monday through Friday at 7:00 AM). Trips must repeat more than once in order to be considered a subscription. Open-ended subscriptions are not permitted. Passengers must indicate an end-date. The maximum length a subscription can last is twelve Subscription reservations are NOT guaranteed and available on a space-available basis. No more than 50% of all trips scheduled for any hour, may be subscription trips.

General Public Passengers

Public General passengers may request a standing order "subscription" for trips that repeat at the same time, on the same day(s); such as for travel to school or work, AND either begin or end at least one guarter (1/4) mile from any Valley Express bus stop. (Reservation requests for trips that begin or end within this distance are not eligible for subscription reservations). Subscriptions may be for one day, (e.g. occur every Tuesday at 1:30 PM); or for multiple days, (e.g. every Monday through Friday at 7:00 AM). Trips must repeat more than once in order to be considered a subscription. Open-ended subscriptions are not permitted. Passengers must indicate an enddate. The maximum length a subscription can last is twelve (12) months. Subscription reservations are NOT quaranteed and available on a spaceavailable basis. No more than 50% of all trips scheduled for any hour may be subscription trips.

Intercity Reservations

ADA Certified Passengers

Intercity Dial-a-ride service between Fillmore/Piru, Santa Paula, and/or Ventura (to Wells Rd.) is available with prior reservation. This service is provided on a space-available basis, and is not guaranteed. Scheduled pickup time may be beyond one hour window from the passenger's requested pickup time.

General Public Passengers

Intercity Dial-a-ride is not available to the general public. Passengers are instructed to use VCTC 126.

Scheduling

ADA Certified Passengers

Passengers trips reserved in advance shall be scheduled for within one-hour of the requested pickup time. Passengers <u>must</u> be offered a pickup time that is within one hour of the requested pickup time; service may not be denied for advance reservations. Same day requests/service is subject to availability.

General Public Passengers

Passenger trip requests are called in same day and handled on an as-available basis, scheduled "first come, first served." Trip availability is not guaranteed, and pickups times may be offered to passenger that are greater than one-hour from the requested pickup time. Additional unscheduled service is available at the VCTC HWY 126 bus locations scheduled to pickup following the arrival of the HWY 126 bus. Seating on these trips are on a space available basis, unless otherwise called in advance.

<u>Cancellations</u>, <u>No-Shows and On-time Window</u> (Applies to ADA Certified/General Public Passengers)

Cancellations

Operator must be notified of cancellations at least two hours before the scheduled pick-up time. Cancellations made less than two (2) hours in advance will count as a "late cancellation." Late cancellations impact service availability and have a negative impact on the system. Excessive late cancellations could result in a warning, and if continued result in suspension of Dial-a-ride services. Passengers will be warned prior to any suspension of service due to late cancellations.

No Show Policy


A no-show is when a passenger fails to board an on-time Dial-a-ride vehicle. A passenger will be considered a no-show if they do not board within five (5) minutes of the vehicle's arrival at the scheduled pickup location. A trip is considered on-time if it arrives within the "on-time window." Drivers and/or dispatchers may attempt to contact the passenger using the contact information/instructions provided during the reservation. Drivers may not lose line-of-sight with vehicles that have passengers on-board (e.g. may not enter an apartment or medical building). No-shows negatively impact service and reduce availability for other riders. Excessive no-shows could result in a warning, and if continued, result in suspension of Dial-a-ride services for the passenger. Passengers will be warned prior to any suspension of service due to no-shows.

On-time Window

The on-time window refers to the period of time which the vehicle may arrive to the scheduled pickup location and the passenger is expected to be ready to board. The on-time window is thirty (30) minutes from the scheduled pickup time. That is the scheduled time "plus thirty" minutes. For example, if a trip is scheduled for 2:00 PM pickup, the on-time window is between 2:00 to 2:30 PM. Trips that arrive after the on-time window are considered late or missed. Passengers who refuse a late or missed trip will NOT be subject to disciplinary action.






EXISTING DIAL-A-RIDE SERVICE AREA: Restricted (Fixed Route) Service Area
