



VISTA Coastal Express Transfer Fee Evaluation

Title VI Program

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1.0 Introduction

1.1 Purpose

The Federal Transit Administration (FTA) Title VI regulations require the Ventura County Transportation Commission (VCTC) evaluate significant system-wide service and fare changes at the planning and programming stages to determine whether those changes will have a discriminatory impact on minority and low-income populations.

The Ventura County Transportation Commission (VCTC) manages the Ventura Intercity Transit Authority (VISTA). VCTC is considering implementing a one way transfer fee of \$1.50 on all passengers transferring from Santa Barbara Metropolitan Transit District (SBMTD) to the VISTA Coastal Express.

The report describes the evaluation process, analysis and findings of the proposed fare increase. Evaluation is in accordance with the VCTC Title VI Program and methodology described in FTA Circular 4702.1A and in compliance with 49 CFR Section 21.5(b)(2), 49 CFR Section 21.5(b)(7) and Appendix C to 49 CFR part 21.

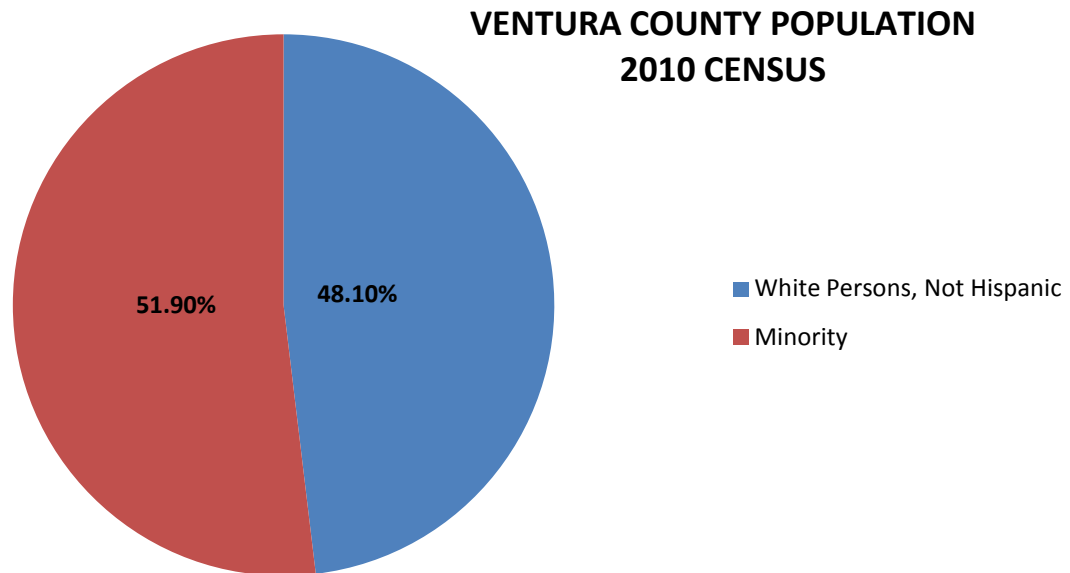
2.0 Background

2.1 Demographic Profile Charts

In order to comply with 49 CFR Section 21.9(b), VCTC is required to collect and analyze racial, ethnic, and low-income data showing the extent to which members of minority and low-income groups are beneficiaries of programs receiving Federal financial assistance. VCTC has selected FTA recommended Option A: Demographic and Service Profile Maps and Charts. The maps and charts are prepared to help determine whether transit service is available to minority and low-income populations within the recipient's service area.

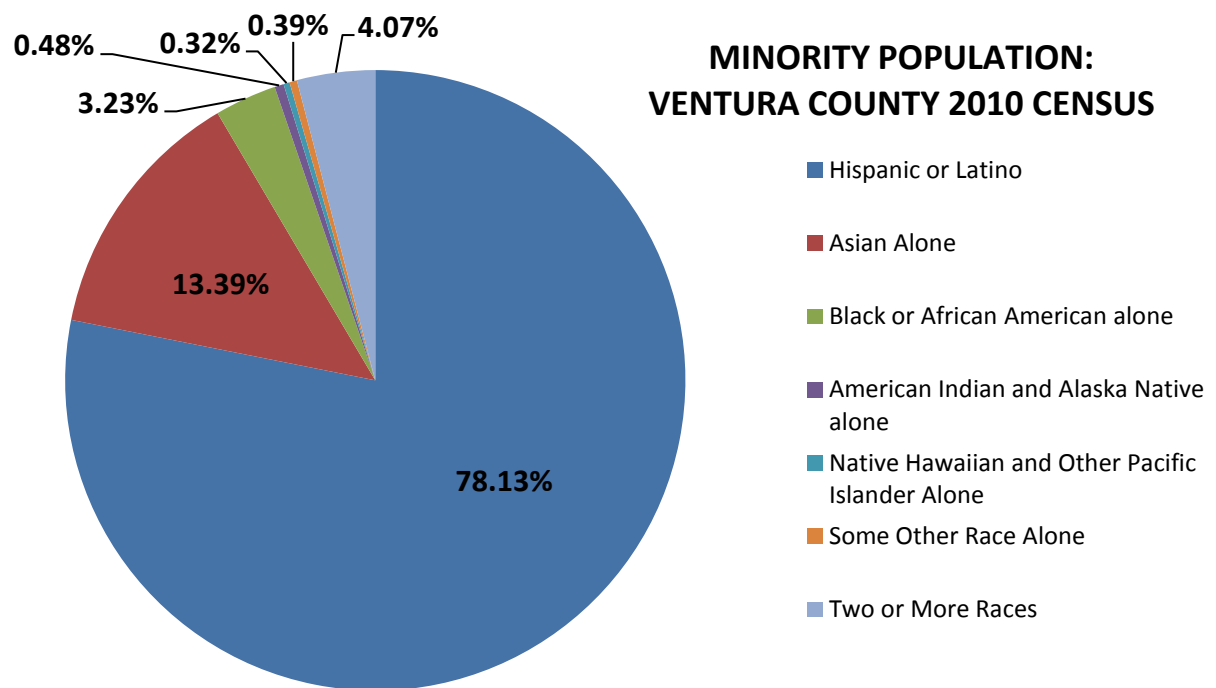
Minority Census Tracts: Using the definitions provided in FTA Circular 4702.1A, a minority census tract is defined as a tract where the percentage of the total minority population residing in the tract exceeds the average minority population in Ventura County (the VISTA service area). Based on year 2006-2010 American Community Survey data, the minority population in Ventura County represented 51.9% of the total population as shown in Figure 1. Therefore, census tracts with a minority population over 51.9% are considered minority tracts for the purpose of this analysis.

The pie chart shown in Figure 2 provides a breakdown of the minority groups based on year 2010 Census data.

Low-Income Census Tracts: A low-income census tract is defined as a tract where the percentage of the low-income population residing in the tract exceeds the average low-income population in Ventura County (the Coastal Express service area). For purposes of this analysis, a low-income census tract is defined as a tract where the average median household income is equal or less than 80% of the average County median household income from the 2010 Census. The average median household income in Ventura County in the 2010 Census was \$75,348. Therefore, a low-income census tract is defined as a tract where the average median household income is at or under \$60,278 (80% of \$75,348).

Census Tract Charts: The chart which identifies the minority census tracts in Ventura County including numbers and percentages of for each minority group within each tract is provided in Attachment 3. Attachment 4 presents the average median household income for each tract and identifies the low-income tracts.

2.2 VISTA System Description

The Ventura Intercity Service Transit Authority (VISTA) began operating in July 1994 as a three-year federal demonstration program funded with federal Congestion Mitigation and Air Quality (CMAQ) funds. Today, VISTA operates seven regular fixed-route bus routes and two general public dial-a-ride services in the cities of Santa Paula, Fillmore, and the unincorporated community of Piru.

The Ventura County Transportation Commission (VCTC) operates the system by contracting with private bus companies who provide the drivers, dispatchers and all buses (based on VCTC specifications), and maintain all vehicles. VISTA carried 80,000 passengers during its first year of service in FY94/95 and grew to almost 600,000 passengers in FY 03/04 about the same time the first VCTC Title VI Program developed. Seven years later in FY 10/11, total passenger ridership on VISTA increased to 1,008,648; a 68% percent increase in ridership.

2.3 Coastal Express Route Description

VCTC worked cooperatively with the Santa Barbara County Association of Governments (SBCAG) to implement the Coastal Express in FY01/02, providing bus service seven days a week between Ventura, Carpinteria, and Santa Barbara, with weekday extensions to Goleta and UCSB. VCTC and SBCAG both share the cost of the Coastal Express route. There are approximately 21 round trips; however, bus stop locations vary significantly by time of day based on commute patterns. Headways vary, but average less than one hour. Service starts as early as 4:35 a.m. and ends 8:59 p.m. A map of the route is below, see Figure 3.

3.0 Transfer Fee Evaluation Methodology

According to Chapter 5 of FTA Circular 4702.1A, the following two options are recommended by FTA to evaluate the impacts of fare changes:

- **Option A:** Evaluate the impacts of proposed fare changes according to the following procedure:
 - (1) Assess the effects of the proposed transfer fee on minority and low-income populations. For proposed changes that would increase or decrease fares on certain transit modes, VCTC would be required to analyze any available information generated from ridership surveys indicating whether minority and low-income riders are more likely to use the mode of service that would be subject to the fare increase.
 - (2) Assess the alternatives available for the people affected by the fare increase. VCTC would be required to analyze what, if any, alternative transit modes are available for people affected by the fare change. This analysis should compare the fares paid under the change with fares that would be paid through available alternatives.
 - (3) Describe the actions the agency proposes to minimize, mitigate, or offset any adverse effects of the proposed fare change on minority and low-income populations.
 - (4) Determine if the proposal(s) under consideration would have a disproportionately high and adverse effect on minority and/or low-income riders. VCTC may implement a fare increase that would have disproportionately high and adverse effects provided that VCTC demonstrates the action meets a substantial need that is in the public interest and that alternative would have more severe adverse effects than the preferred alternative.
- **Option B:** Develop a local evaluation procedure. VCTC has the option of modifying Option A or developing their own procedures to evaluate significant fare changes to determine whether those changes have a discriminatory impact.

The methodology described in **Option A** above was selected to evaluate the impacts of the proposed transfer fee presented in this report.

4.0 Evaluation & Findings

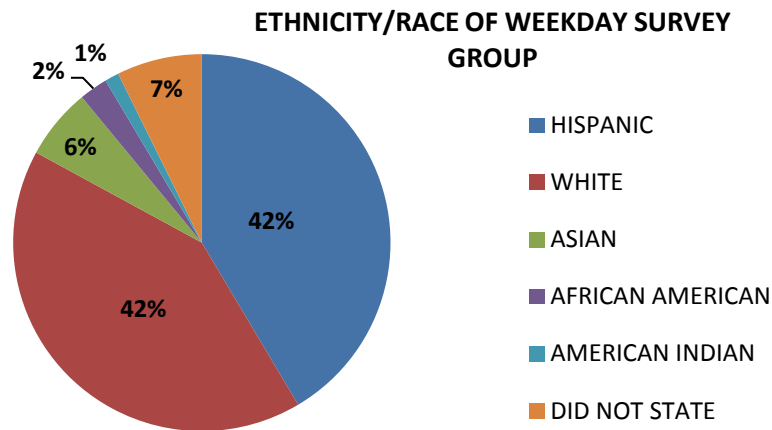
4.1 Assessing the Effects of the Proposed Fee Implementation

On-board passenger surveys were conducted June 4th-8th 2012 to provide information for this evaluation. Surveys were distributed and collected by individual bus drivers, and were available in both English and Spanish. Surveys were conducted during both the weekday and weekend. A copy of the survey is presented in Attachment 1.

Race/Ethnicity

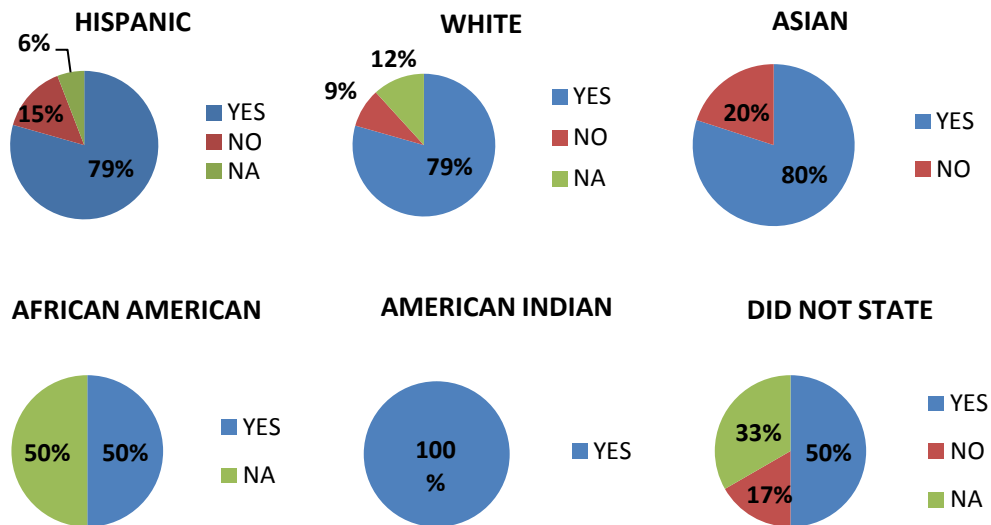
Weekday Survey Results

82 passengers completed VCTC's weekday survey. Of those 82 individuals, 34 identified themselves as Hispanic, 34 as White, 6 did not state, 5 as Asian, 2 as African American, and 1 as American Indian. See illustration below for percent breakdowns.



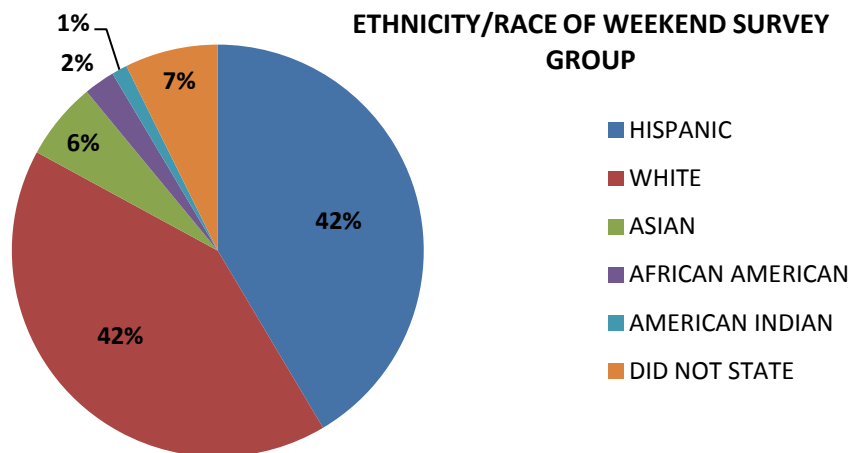
Of the 34 self-identified Hispanics, 27 responded that they will continue to ride VISTA if a transfer fee is implemented. 5 individuals responded that they will no longer ride VISTA if the fee is implemented, and 2 did not state. Of the 34 self-identified Whites, 27 responded that they will continue to ride VISTA if a transfer fee is implemented. 3 individual's responded that they will no longer ride VISTA if the fee is implemented, and 4 did not state. Of the 6 individuals who did not identify with any race/ethnicity, 3 said they will continue to ride VISTA if a transfer fee is implemented. 1 individual responded that he will no longer ride VISTA if the fee is implemented, and 2 did not state. Of the 5 self-identified Asians surveyed, 4 responded that they will continue to ride VISTA if a transfer fee is implemented. 1 individual responded that he will no longer ride the VISTA if the fee is implemented. Of the 2 self-identified African Americans surveyed, 1 will continue to ride if the transfer fee is implemented and 1 did not state. The 1 self-identifying American Indian will continue to ride if a transfer fee is implemented.

The following graphs provide a breakdown of passenger responses to question 1 by Ethnicity/Race. Question 1 asked whether a passenger would continue to ride VISTA if a \$1.50 transfer fee was implemented. A “Yes” response signifies that the passenger surveyed will continue to ride VISTA if a transfer fee is implemented and a “No” response signifies the passenger surveyed will not continue to ride VISTA if a transfer fee is implemented.



Weekend Survey Results

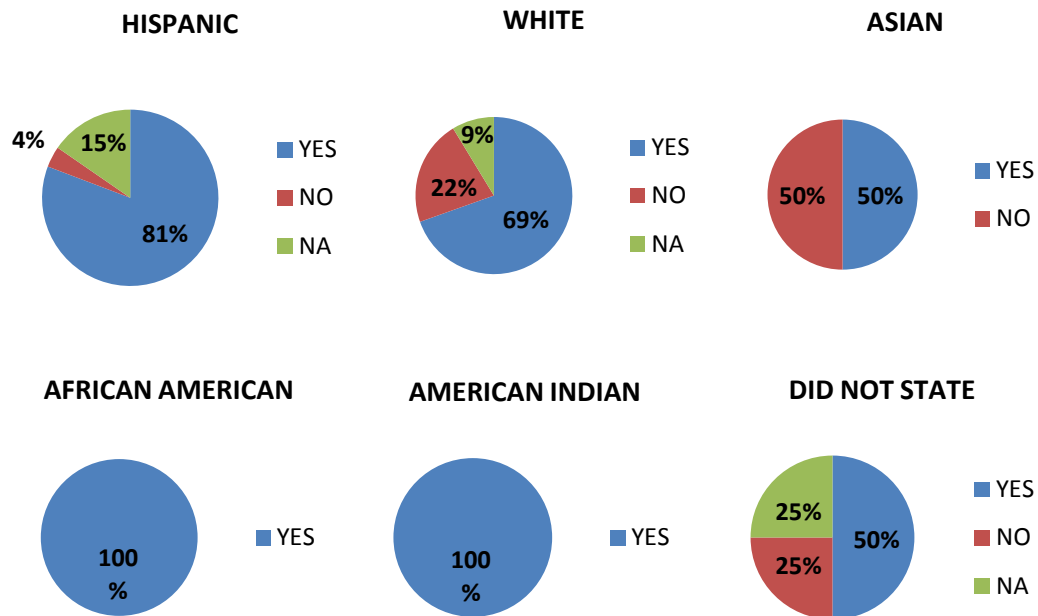
61 weekend passengers completed VCTC's weekend survey. Of those 60 individuals, 26 identified themselves as Hispanic, 23 as White, 4 did not state, 3 as African American, 2 as Asian, and 2 as American Indian. See illustration below for percent breakdowns.



Of the 26 self-identified Hispanics, 21 responded that they will continue to ride VISTA if a transfer fee is implemented, 1 will not, and 4 did not state. Of the 23 self-identified Whites, 16 responded that they will continue to ride VISTA if a transfer fee is implemented, 5 answered that they will not, and 2 did not state. Of the 3 self-identified African Americans surveyed, all 3

will continue to ride VISTA if the transfer fee is implemented. Of the 4 individuals who did not identify with any race/ethnicity, 2 will continue to ride VISTA if a transfer fee is implemented, 1 will not, and 1 did not state. Of the 2 self-identified Asians, 1 will continue to ride if a transfer fee is implemented and 1 will not. The 2 self-identifying American Indians will continue to ride if a transfer fee is implemented.

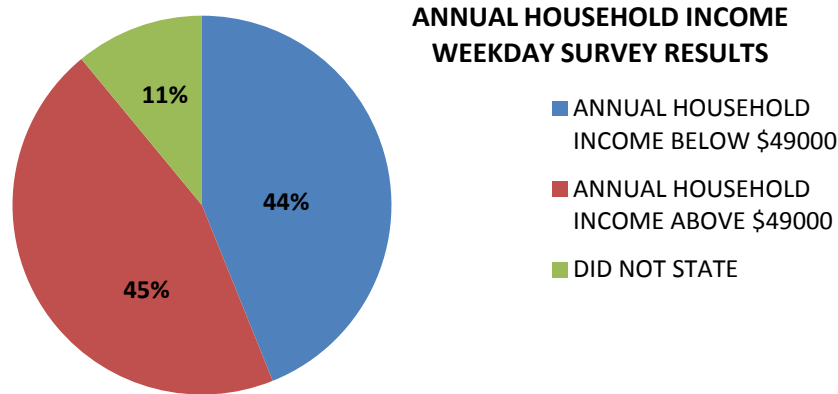

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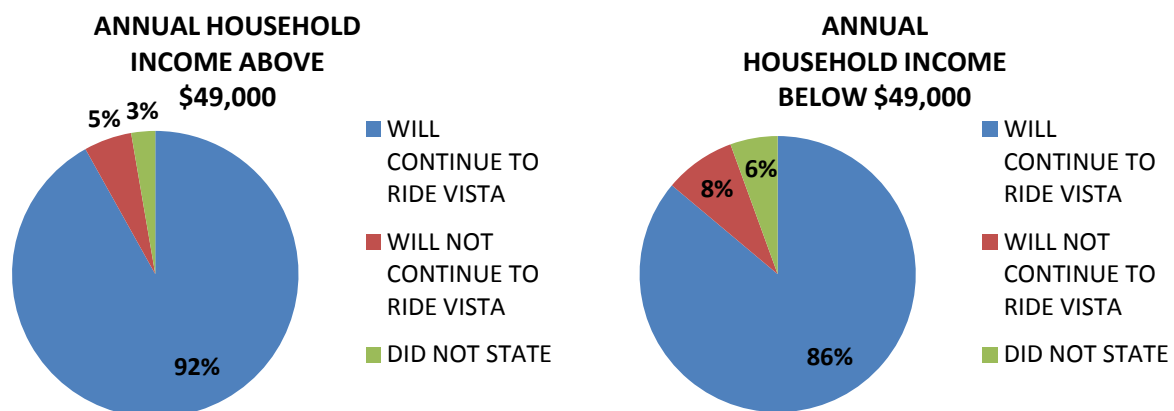
Income**Weekday Survey Results**

Of the 82 individuals who completed the weekday survey, 37 reported having a household income of \$49,000 or higher, 36 reported having a household income below \$49,000, and 9 did not state.



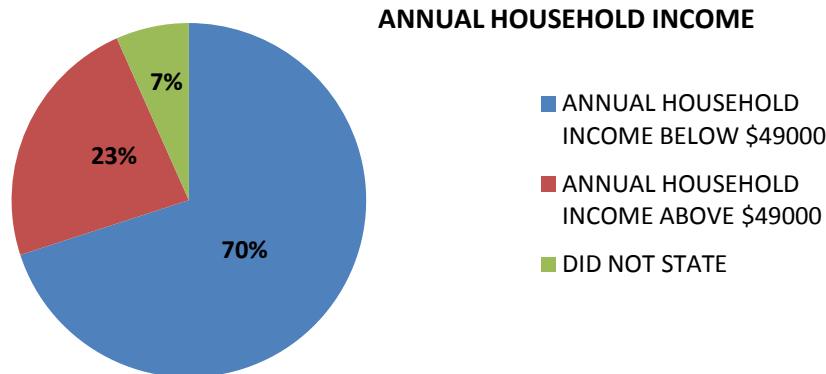
From the 37 passengers who reported having a household income of \$49,000 or higher, 34 will continue to ride if a transfer fee is implemented, 2 will not, and 1 did not state. Of the 36 passengers who reported having a household income below \$49,000, 31 will continue to ride if a transfer fee is implemented, 3 will not, and 2 did not state.

The following graphs provide a breakdown of passenger responses to question 1 of the weekday survey according to their reported annual household income. Question 1 asked whether a passenger would continue to ride VISTA if a \$1.50 transfer fee was implemented. A “Yes” response signifies that the passenger surveyed will continue to ride VISTA if a transfer fee is implemented and a “No” response signifies the passenger surveyed will not continue to ride VISTA if a transfer fee is implemented.



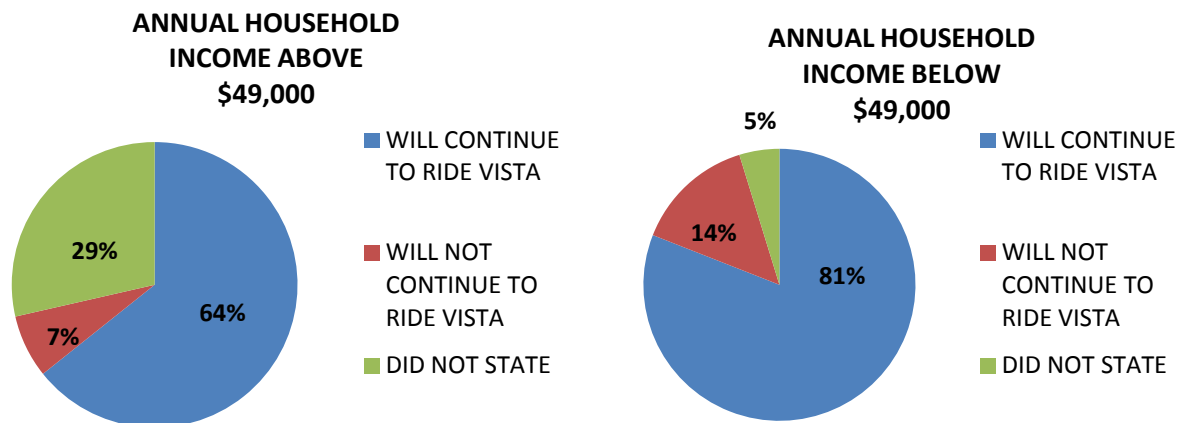
Weekend Survey Results

Of the 60 individuals who completed the weekend survey, 14 reported having a household income of \$49,000 or higher, 42 reported having a household income below \$49,000, and 4 did not state.



From the 14 passengers who reported having a household income of \$49,000 or higher, 9 will continue to ride if a transfer fee is implemented, 1 will not, and 4 did not state. Of the 42 passengers who reported having a household income below \$49,000, 34 will continue to ride if a transfer fee is implemented, 6 will not, and 2 did not state.

The following graphs provide a breakdown of passenger responses to question 1 of the weekend survey according to their reported annual household income. Question 1 asked whether a passenger would continue to ride VISTA if a \$1.50 transfer fee was implemented. A “Yes” response signifies that the passenger surveyed will continue to ride VISTA if a transfer fee is implemented and a “No” response signifies the passenger surveyed will not continue to ride VISTA if a transfer fee is implemented.



Overall Impact

According to this survey the SBMTD transfer fee will **not** have a **significant** impact on minority and low-income communities. This is not to say those communities will not be impacted at all, but rather that the impacts will be small and manageable. Most passengers who stated they will no longer ride the Coastal Express if such a transfer fee is implemented have alternative methods already lined up. They include driving themselves, carpooling, and walking to work.

10 passengers answered “No” to question 1 of the weekday survey. 6 identified as a minority. 5 of the 6 had an alternative form of transportation available.

8 passengers answered “No” to question 1 of the weekend survey. 2 identified as a minority, 1 did not have an alternative form of transportation available.

10 passengers answered “No” to question 1 of the weekday survey. 2 had household incomes of \$49,000 or above, 3 had a household income below \$49,000, and 5 did not state.

8 passengers answered “No” to question 1 of the weekend survey. 1 had a household income of \$49,000 or above, 6 had a household income below \$49,000, and 1 did not state.

4.2 Assessing Transportation Alternatives

Based on a review of available transportation alternatives summarized in Figure 4 (shown below), none are comparable to the Coastal Express in terms of service provided and value. Carpools and vanpools appear to be the only cost-competitive options to riding VISTA, depending on the number of occupants per vehicle and driving distance, as highlighted in Figure 5. The cost/trip figures for vanpools in Figure 4 assume full occupancy. Figure 5 also shows that driving alone is not cost competitive except for short trips.

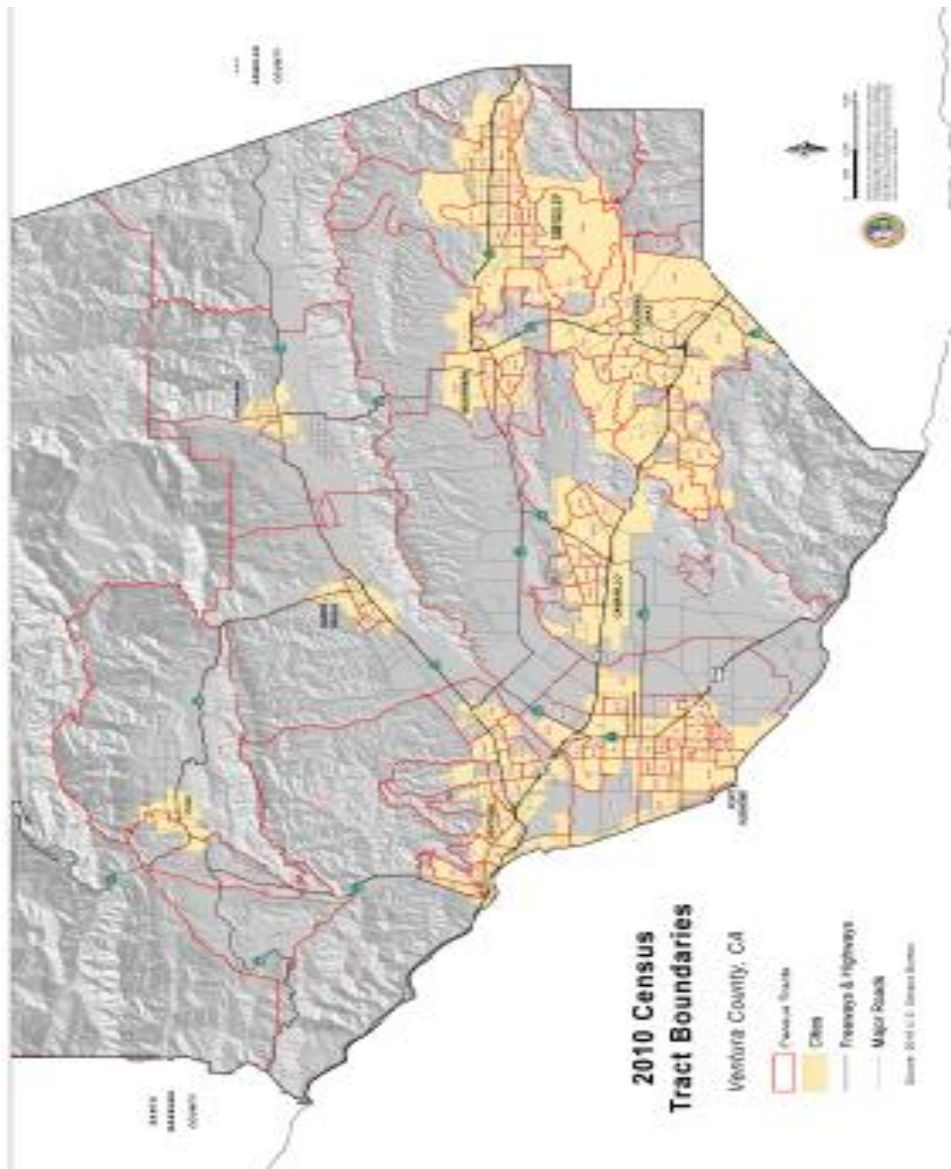
