June 20, 2013 Meeting

#### Item # 1 Call to Order

Vice-Chair Ken Matsuoka of Camarillo called the meeting to order at 9:07 am. The following people were present:

#### **Item #2 Public Comments**

There were no public comments

#### Item #3 Approval of May 16, 2013 Minutes

Ken Matsuoka (Camarillo) moved to approve the minutes; Ben Emami (Ventura County) seconded the motion and it passed unanimously.

#### **Item #4 Caltrans Local Assistance Update**

Robert Wong of Caltrans Local Assistance said that staff is reviewing the anticipated milestone dates for projects to be delivered during the current fiscal year. The deadline for RFA submittal is July 1<sup>st</sup>, so if projects still don't have PS&E or environmental approval they are unlikely to get authorized this year. Kamran Panau of Simi Valley said that his projects are held up in Caltrans Environmental. Robert stated that he would like to know ahead of time if projects anticipated for delivery are being held up somewhere.

Local Assistance staff from District 7 attended a Local Assistance staff conference near Sacramento. There are new programs coming next year, and there are still Buy America issues, so they anticipate

handling many questions. Caltrans' goal is for project sponsors to have the best information up front. They don't want a project sponsor to find out at the end of the project that they must return the funds. Peter De Haan of VCTC asked if there were any anticipated delays due to Buy America, and no one present was aware of any delays.

Robert urged the agencies to watch the Inactive List. They provide a 6-month warning of an inactive project, and must receive an invoice, at the latest, two weeks before the inactive date. Once a project reaches the inactive date, the funds will be deobligated.

Dean Morales of Thousand Oaks asked about the status of the Transportation Alternatives Program (TAP). Robert responded that FHWA has issued final guidelines, but Dean pointed out that even with these guidelines we're not there yet there in terms of being able to move forward with TAP. Peter De Haan of VCTC clarified that MAP-21 provides that Caltrans administers part of the program, and Metropolitan Planning Organizations (in our case SCAG) the other part, and that neither entity has yet provided guidelines on how agencies can apply for funds, or how projects will be selected. There are still two outstanding TE projects that VCTC programmed before it knew that TE would be replaced by TAP, so those projects would be anticipated to apply for funds, whenever that is possible. SCAG has informally indicated interest in apportioning its share of TAP funds to each county, allowing each transportation commission to select projects.

Finally, Robert said that Robert Nguyen, the Local Assistance Headquarters Area Engineer, will be at the July TTAC meeting. He asked that everyone think ahead of time about their questions, and forward them to him (Robert Wong) so that he can provide the questions ahead of time to Robert Nguyen.

#### **Item #5 ADA Requirements on Caltrans Projects**

Robert Wong introduced Yunus Ghousi, the Caltrans District 7 ADA Coordinator, who participated in the meeting by phone. Yunus explained that in 2008 or 2009, Caltrans' ADA programmed was challenged in court, with the result that Caltrans has updated its ADA program elements. In response to a question from Kamran Panau, Yunus said that Caltrans addressed the issue of a street that is steeper than the maximum allowable ramp grade for a project on Route 1 in Los Angeles County, using a special "step by step design." But in a situation where the grade is structural impracticable, then the rules provided in 28 CFR 35.151 must be followed to alter the facility to achieve the standard, possibly over the long term through developing a Transition Plan.

Dean Morales commented that if the maximum grade cannot be achieved, Thousand Oaks will remove the wheelchair access due to ensure safety. Yunus said documentation of such a decision is needed to consider the availability of alternate routes and whether there is any pedestrian activity. In response to a question from Peter De Haan, Yunus said that for projects in the state right-of-way, an agency must document why an ADA standard is infeasible, and then request a design exception. For projects not in the state right-of-way, Caltrans could consult with FHWA if a standard cannot be met.

Dave Klotzle of Moorpark asked if the street does not comply with ADA, must the pedestrian facilities comply. Yunus answered that if there are no complaints or grievances then the city can develop a Transition Plan.

Yunus stated that the Caltrans ADAAG website shows the grievances against Caltrans. These have the highest priority. He asked that any complaints received by local agencies regarding facilities on the Caltrans right-of-way be entered on the ADAAG website, regardless of whether the complaint came by e-mail, phone, or by memo.

Robert asked if there is any federal training available, and Yunus responded that there is. Ken Matsuoka said that this training might be a good idea. Robert said he would check into the available of the training. Ken said it would be good to provide the trainer ahead of time with project-specific examples for which agencies have questions.

#### **Item #6 Congestion Management Program Update**

Peter De Haan reported that the CMP document is nearly complete and should be ready for TTAC review in August. The Committee requested that VCTC provide plenty of time to review the draft document prior to the meeting.

SUBJECT: STREAMLINING DELIVERY FEDERAL TRANSPORTATION PROJECTS

#### **RECOMMENDATION:**

Discuss regional agency presentation on federal project streamlining.

#### **BACKGROUND:**

Last December the regional transportation planning agencies established a task force to explore opportunities for streamlining the delivery of federally-funded projects administered by Caltrans Local Assistance. The task force brainstormed a number of alternatives for simplifying project delivery, and prepared a matrix which was presented at a workshop in Sacramento on June 10<sup>th</sup>. Many of the ideas mentioned, particularly the strategies to consolidate the number of times that Caltrans must process a project authorization, can be accomplished by local and regional agencies without changing state of federal policies. Other strategies that will likely require policy changes were listed separately at the end of the presentation as "Concepts for Future Consideration."

At the meeting staff will present the workshop material for Committee discussion. The agenda transmittal includes the summary matrix prepared by the regional agencies task force, and the workshop presentation. Staff is interested in getting Committee feedback on the possible applicability of these strategies in this county.

SUBJECT: STATUS OF FEDERAL STP, CMAQ, AND TE PROJECTS

#### **RECOMMENDATION:**

Update project schedules.

#### **DISCUSSION:**

Under federal law, STP, CMAQ, and TE funds apportioned to California lapse if they are not used within three years. AB 1012, which became law in October, 1999, applies the three-year lapsing rule to CMAQ and STP funds in each county. Furthermore, since, under California Transportation Commission (CTC) policy, TE funds are programmed based on County shares through the STIP, there are STIP timely-use requirements that apply to these funds. For these reasons, it is important for VCTC to have an accurate schedule of STP, CMAQ, and TE fund obligations. VCTC also uses this project schedule to ensure that the FTIP includes all of the projects which are ready-to-go and to manage the county's Obligational Authority (OA).

The attachment includes tables showing the status of all incomplete STP, CMAQ, and TE projects. Staff requests that agencies email their project updates prior to the meeting, if possible.
