# MINUTES OF THE VENTURA COUNTY TRANSPORTATION COMMISSION (VCTC) TRANSPORTATION TECHNICAL ADVISORY COMMITTEE (TTAC)

April 21, 2016

#### 1. Call to Order

Chair Tom Mericle called the meeting to order at 9:02 a.m. A quorum was present. The following people were in attendance:

#### 2. Announcements

VCTC is holding a Special Meeting on April 22, 2016. The cities of Ventura and Santa Paula are considering sales tax measures. Recently, FHWA published a list of projects with unobligated earmarked balances. Staff advised only two projects in Ventura County have earmarked funding that can be spent, the Highway Cameras Monitoring Project and the Ronald Regan Freeway Landscaping Project. Ben Cacatian will be overseeing the VCAPCD Rule 211 Program, which is the employer commute survey program. Public Works Director of City of Ventura, Rick Raives announced his retirement, effective September 9.

#### 3. Public Comments

No public comments were made.

#### 4. February 18, 2016 Meeting Minutes - Action

Cliff Finley moved to approve the February 18, 2016 meeting minutes. Ken Matsuoka seconded the motion, which passed with no objections.

#### **5. Caltrans Local Assistance Updates**

Caltrans provided status updates on active projects and projects needing to be closed.

#### 6. Issues of Topics for Caltrans Quarterly Meetings

TTAC discussed Caltrans providing an overview of the annual or biennial permitting process for local construction projects at the next Quarterly meeting.

#### 7. County of Ventura CMAQ Project Fund Funding – Action

Cliff Finley moved to approve the staff recommendation of transfer of \$160,000 of CMAQ funds from the construction phase of the Rio Real Elementary School Pedestrian Street Improvement Project to the Camarillo Heights and Somis Elementary School Pedestrian Improvement Project. Kamran Panah seconded the motion, which passed with no objections.

#### 8. Status of Federal CMAQ/STP Projects

Staff provided tables that included CMAQ and STP project obligation and prior status information. Staff requested schedule updates on all projects. TTAC members provided verbal updates on projects to staff.

#### 9. ATP Cycle 3 Call for Projects Update

The ATP Cycle 3 was released at end of March 2016, applications will be due on June 15 and funding will be available in FY 2019/20 and FY 2020/21. Staff provided suggestions to TTAC on potential improvements to applications (i.e. detailed maps, letters of support, reference of existing plans). An ATP Cycle 3 workshop was held on April 19 at the Camarillo. Stephen Patchan from SCAG provided a presentation on the ATP Cycle 3 process, draft application and application scoring rubric.

#### 10. Future Agenda Items

Discussions regarding ATP Cycle 3 will continue. A presentation from City of Ventura on Class IV bicycle paths will occur at the May TTAC meeting. An update regarding the Congestion Management Plan will occur as soon as possible.

#### 11. Adjournment – Action

Chair Tom Mericle moved to adjourn the meeting at 10:36 a.m., which passed with no objection.
