ITEM 6 ACTIVE TRANSPORTATION PROGRAM CYCLE 4 LOCAL PRIORITIZATION METHODOLOGY

Ms. Judith Johnduff, VCTC, provided an overview of the ATP Cycle 4 Call-for-Projects and the proposed methodology for prioritizing local projects for funding under the MPO component of Cycle 4 program. Ken Matsuoka noted that the Plan listed on the Adopted List of Plans was not current for the City of Camarillo. TTAC members recommended sending an email to agencies soliciting additional input to update the list and also recommended removing any plans older than 10 years old unless agencies indicated that the plan is still current.
