

Freeway Service Patrol (FSP) is a fleet of roaming tow trucks ready to assist disabled vehicles on certain portions of Ventura County highways.



The program is provided at no charge to the motoring public, and in partnership by Ventura County Transportation Commission (VCTC), Caltrans, and the California Highway Patrol (CHP).

HOW DO I CONTACT FSP?

For non-emergency services, call CHP Dispatch at 805.477.4174. Emergency? Dial 911.

WHEN DOES FSP OPERATE?

FSP operates Monday through Friday, except certain holidays, from 6:30 a.m. to 9:30 a.m., and from 2:00 p.m. to 6:00 p.m.

IS THERE A COST TO USE THIS SERVICE?

There is no cost to the motorist. The program is paid for by local and state transportation funds.

HOW WILL I RECOGNIZE FSP?

Look for the FSP and VCTC logos. FSP drivers wear blue uniforms with yellow safety vests featuring the FSP logo.

CAN I TIP THE DRIVER?

FSP drivers are not permitted to accept any form of payment, gifts, or tip.

DID YOU KNOW ...

FSP roaming tow trucks are one of the best solutions to keep Ventura County moving. FSP reduces traffic jams by quickly clearing disabled vehicles, ultimately reducing harmful emissions and preventing secondary accidents. FSP may respond beyond regular service areas as needed to assist the CHP.

FSP CAN ASSIST WITH:

- Changing flat tires
- Jump starting dead batteries
- Refilling radiators and taping leaky hoses
- Providing a gallon of fuel

TOWING SERVICES

If FSP cannot quickly get your vehicle running, vehicles will be towed to a safe location at no charge, where you may wait for additional assistance. Upon request, FSP will contact the CHP to request a tow or contact another party for help.
